The Board of Directors of Chimney Hill Municipal Utility District is pleased to announce that we have added recycling service to the District's solid waste collection contract with Waste Corporation of Texas, LP (also known as WCA Waste). WCA's proposal for extension of the District's solid waste collection contract contained very favorable rates. As a result, the District was able to add recycling to the contract without increasing the cost per household. Therefore, WCA will now provide District residents with solid waste collection plus recycling at no added cost.

The recycling service will be accomplished using a 48-gallon wheeled cart. WCA will deliver a cart to each resident on or about April 25. Saturdays will be recycling day in the District. The first recycling day will be Saturday, May 7.

WCA's program is a "single stream" recycling program, meaning that all recyclables can be put in the same cart. Please see the attached notice from WCA setting forth guidelines for recyclable materials.
