

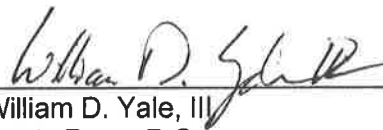

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Chimney Hill Municipal Utility District of Harris County, Texas, will hold a **special meeting**, open to the public, on **FRIDAY, 17 NOVEMBER 2017**, at **12:30 P.M.**, at the offices of Coats Rose, P.C., **9 Greenway Plaza, Suite 1100, Houston, Texas**, outside the boundaries of the District, for the purposes of considering and acting upon the following matters:

1. Consider comments and questions from residents of the District;
2. Minutes of the Board of Directors meetings of 11 and 27 October 2017;
3. Bookkeeper's Report, including:
  - (a) payment of the District's bills;
  - (b) review District's investments, Investment Report, and Depository Pledge Report;
  - (c) review and approve payment of Directors Fees of Office;
4. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including:
  - (a) authorize payments from the District's tax account;
  - (b) status report regarding delinquent tax accounts, and authorize actions deemed necessary;
  - (c) review and approve Assignment and Assumption of Agreement for Services of Tax Assessor/Collector;
  - (d) review and approve Amendment to Agreement for Services of Tax Assessor/Collector;
5. Discuss District's web site, and authorize actions deemed necessary, including:
  - (a) status of inquiries from residents;
  - (b) review and discuss format of web site;
6. New business, including:
  - (a) approve engagement letter with Arbitrage Compliance Specialists, Inc. for arbitrage rebate calculations (Series 2009 Refunding Bonds, final computation period);
  - (b) consider rescheduling 1/26/18 Board meeting (AWBD Mid-Winter Conference);
7. Old business, including:
  - (a) discuss proposals for solid waste collection & recycling service and authorize actions deemed necessary;
  - (b) discuss proposed walking trail project (Chimney Hill Community Association, Inc.) and authorize actions deemed necessary;
  - (c) discuss proposed annexation of 26.127-acre tract on Eldridge Parkway (SRP-H NW Logistics Center, L.P.) and authorize actions deemed necessary;
